Good afternoon All Saints' families,

The term is well underway! We have awarded Pupil Responsibility badges this week, ready for pupils to commence their roles:

In Reception, children will continue to use the Little Wandle letter rhymes, focussing on formation. KS1 will use our new scheme Nelson Handwriting to build on consistency of size and sitting letters on the line, whilst KS2 focus on joining and fluency. All children have weekly transcription lessons to help them focus on this.
