Morning Gate

A reminder that the school gate opens at 8:40AM, to allow pupils to start making their way in to school. At 8:50AM, the gates will close, to ensure that pupils are in their classrooms and ready to promptly commence their learning at 8:55AM.

Side Gate

Thank you all for your support with regards the closing of the side gate, and the reasons for why I had to make the decision I made. Moving forwards, to support each other in keeping our children safe, please ensure you are parking safely on the road to allow pedestrians to pass safely. Please also remember to enter/leave the car park safely as there are so many small children walking through the space.

Holidays in Term Time

I just wanted to take this opportunity to remind you of the rules regards taking children on term time holidays. The local council can give each parent a fine of £80, rising to £160 if you do not pay within 21 days. From the 2024 to 2025 school year, each parent will only get up to 2 fines for the same child in a 3-year period.

If you get a second fine in 3 years, it will be £160. If you do not pay the fine in 28 days you may be taken to court for keeping your child out of school.

If your child is off school 3 or more times within the 3 years you will not be fined but may be taken to court. You could get a fine of up to £2,500, a community order or a jail sentence up to 3 months. The court could also give you a Parenting Order.

Staffing

I know that many of you have questions around the current staffing arrangements for Teachers in school. For the time being, Mrs Forsyth will continue to work in Chestnut, and Miss Henriques in Beech Class – both are valuable members of the team! I would like to reassure you that we are working our very hardest to maintain standards and ensure your children are happy and settled. As soon as I have any, I will provide you with further updates.

As some of you may be aware, Mrs Glaze has taken over from Julie in the After School Club role. I know that she will be a fantastic asset to school – welcome to the team Mrs Glaze! Furthermore, Mrs Prosser will, unfortunately, be leaving us at the end of term. Mrs Prosser is an amazing asset to All Saints' and she will be truly missed by many of us. Her family are moving abroad – so we would like to wish them every success in their new venture.
