MATHS AND ENGLISH

+Maths:

Year 1 will be counting, reading and writing numbers to 20, finding one more and one less, and comparing groups using objects, pictures and number lines. **Year 2** will be working with numbers to 100, recognising tens and ones, partitioning numbers, and counting in 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s.

English:

Year 1 will focus on writing simple sentences with capital letters, spaces, and full stops, while learning to use nouns, verbs, and adjectives. **Year 2** will build on this by joining sentences with conjunctions and using a wider range of punctuation, including question marks, exclamation marks, and commas in lists.

FOUNDATION SUBJECTS



We will develop fundamental movement skills, use different equipment, and focus on fitness by exploring agility, stamina, balance, and coordination.



Children will explore rhythm, pitch and performance through the units Hands, Feet, Heart and Ho Ho Ho.



This term we will practise iPad basics and typing before creating simple animations.



Our artwork will be inspired by animals, with a focus on the artist John Nieto and his bold use of colour.



Children will design and make their own fairground wheels, learning how simple mechanisms work.



We will learn about healthy lifestyles, including healthy eating and brushing teeth, before exploring bullying and body language.



The children will consider "Who made the world?" and explore why Christmas matters to Christians.
