Test Results

Well done to all of our children who have been formally assessed this year. They should feel really proud of themselves. We are immensely proud of them and all they have achieved. School results are:

- EYFS GLD = 79%
- Y1 PSC = 88%
- MTC = 56%
- Y6 Reading = 89% (EXS) 58% (GDS)
 - Y6 Writing = 79% (EXS) 21% (GDS)
 - Y6 Maths = 89% (EXS) 42% (GDS)
 - Y6 SPaG = 89% (EXS) 63%

Our Year 6 Greater Depth results are the best the school has ever achieved – so a huge congratulations to all involved.
