Fundraising

Our outdoor 'Reading Haven' has been delivered and will be being constructed, ready for the children to access during playtimes and lunchtimes. We've ordered a range of texts to suit all ages and interests – I'm sure the children will absolutely love it.

We've re-stocked the Book Swap Shop and it's lovely to see so many children swapping texts with their friends.

The Thomas Rudge Trust are supporting us with the purchase of some new Phonics and Banded books to support independent reading across the school – this will be a welcome and much needed addition to the school's reading resources.

The PTFA have also agreed to donate some funding towards a library revamp to make the area more inviting and to stock it with magazines and audio books.

We have also had some volunteers to read with their child's class for 10-15 minutes – if you are happy to take part, please let me know and I'll add you to the list.

The PTFA are using some of their funds to purchase a stylus for each child (Y3-Y6) to support the work on their iPads. A stylus helps children use their iPads more effectively by supporting handwriting, fine motor skills, and accurate work in subjects like maths and science. It also encourages creativity, allowing them to draw, annotate, and highlight naturally, while making learning more engaging and inclusive. Overall, it bridges the gap between traditional writing and digital learning, preparing children for future technology use.
