Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you all for your support and kind words of encouragement this week. This truly is a very special school with a wonderful whole school community. Can I add a special thank you to all of the parents of the children in years 3 to 6 for supporting the whole school's safety by keeping their children at home this week. I know from personal experience that home-schooling can be hard work but you have all done a wonderful job of supporting your children with their learning.

Oak and Elm Class Update

I am thrilled to be informing you that we will be welcoming all of children back into school on Monday 11th October. We will, however, be keeping the stricter COVID measures in place that were implemented last week following the guidance of Staffordshire local authority. Please can you continue to regularly use lateral flow tests to check that your children do not have COVID and keep your children at home and obtain a PCR test, if your child develops a new continuous cough, has a high temperature or loses their sense of taste or smell. Can I remind everyone that we are requesting that all children have a PCR test before returning to school on Monday, unless they have had a positive COVID Test in the last 90 days.

Harvest

Unfortunately, we have had to cancel the harvest festival at All Saints' Church on Monday. We are however still accepting donations that will be given to the church to put with their offerings for Outreach for Wolverhampton, who support the homeless.

Year 5 and 6 Visit

Year 5 and 6's planned trip to the Black Country Museum will still be going ahead on Monday 18th October. I have consulted with the museum regarding their risk assessments and the Local Outbreak Team have advised that the visit can still take place.

Parent-Teacher Consultations

Because of the restrictions that are in place under the guidance of the local authority, Parent-Teacher consultations will take place via MS TEAMS on Tuesday 19th October and Thursday 21st October. This does mean that you will be unable to see your children's work at this time. Therefore, we will be sending home a copy of your child's favourite piece of writing and maths work so far so that your child can share this with you. School will be in touch next week regarding how you make an appointment to meet with your child's teacher.

I look forward to seeing you and your children on Monday morning and hope that you all have a restful weekend.
