Attendance Update

I would like to say a big thank you for ensuring that your children are at school every day and are here on time. Our whole school attendance is currently at 96.1% for this academic year which is way above the national average of 94.1%. The school's persistent absenteeism figure (individual children with less than 90% attendance) are the lowest across the eight schools in our Multi-Academy Trust. These are fantastic statistics, and I am extremely proud that the whole school is now working together to ensure that our attendance is on its way to becoming 'outstanding'.

Congratulations to Penny Davis, Gracie Dudley, Esme Harvey, Charlotte Pincher, George Roberts and Millie Roberts who have all achieved 100% attendance this year and as a result will receive a special end of year treat.

Just a polite reminder that holidays in term time will not be authorised and the local authority will be informed of all unauthorised absences resulting in a penalty fines being issued.

Wrap-Around Care Costs

It is with regret that I inform you that due to rising staff wages and food costs, we will be raising the prices of our wrap around care from September. The new prices are as follows:

Breakfast Club: £5.00

Afterschool club until 4.30pm: £5.00

Afterschool club after 4.30pm up to 5.30pm: £5.00

Afterschool club from 3.30pm until 5.30pm: £7.50

Nursery Lunchtime: £4.50

School Lunches

Due the rise in food prices school lunches will be raised to £2.50 per day from September.
