MATHS AND ENGLISH

Maths

Year 1 will be learning about addition and subtraction within 20 using practical resources and number lines. They will also explore geometry, recognising and naming 2D and 3D shapes.

Year 2 will be solving addition and subtraction problems within 100 and learning about geometry, including the properties of 2D and 3D shapes.

English - Grammar and Punctuation

At the start of Spring Term, in English we will be focusing on front-loaded grammar and punctuation skills to support writing.

Year 1 will learn to use progressive verbs, plural nouns ending in -es, question and exclamation marks.

Year 2 will focus on verb suffixes (-ing, -ed), joining clauses with such as 'and', using the prefix un-, and using apostrophes for contractions and possession.

Focus Texts

After Front Loaded Grammar, this term's focus texts are 'Rosie's Glasses', 'The Five Senses', 'Bestsy Buglove Saves the Bees' and 'Save the Bees'. We kindly ask that these texts are not shared with the children yet, as we will be revealing it to them to in school.🐝

PE DAYS

Our PE days this term will be on **Thursdays and Fridays** - if there are any changes to these dates, you will be notified in good time.

Please ensure your child is in appropriate P.E kit and please be mindful that some sessions may be outdoors.

FOUNDATION SUBJECTS

History

We will explore 'Why Do We Remember the Gunpowder Plot?' and 'Why Did Queen Victoria Come to Wolverhampton?', helping children understand significant events and people from the past.

Geography

Our focus will be 'Where Do I Shiver and Swelter?', learning about different climates and how weather affects places around the world.

Science

Biology – 'Why Do Animals Choose to Live Where They Do?'

Children will learn about habitats and how animals are adapted to their environments.

Physics – 'How Do Seasons Change?'

We will explore seasonal changes and understand how they affect our world.

P.E

Children will take part in Gymnastics, Football, Team Building and Invasion Games – developing skills such as teamwork, co-ordination and fitness.

Music

We will explore rhythm, instruments, and performance through the units 'I Wanna Play in a Band' and 'Zoo-time'.

Computing

Children will become Coders and Data Handlers, learning the basics of programming and how to organise and interpret information.

We will explore emotions and relationships, focusing on worry, anger, helping someone in need, stealing, and making positive choices.

RE

Children will learn about 'What Sikhs Believe' and explore 'Why Easter Matters to Christians'.
