

Handwriting

We've purchased a new Handwriting Scheme here at All Saints', which your children will be using with immediate effect. In Reception and Year 1, children will continue to use the Little Wandle letter rhymes, focussing on formation, moving on to sizing and sitting on the line. In Year 2, they will move to Nelson Handwriting and start to utilise joins where applicable. Please see your child's Class Teacher if you want any further information.

Homework

A reminder of homework expectations across school:

Nursery

· Sharing stories with an adult (share stories using the pictures in the book instead of the words. Read stories repeatedly so your child becomes familiar with them)

Reception

· Reception – 15 minutes of reading a day

Year 1 to Year 6

- · Monday 15 minutes of reading plus spelling practice
- Tuesday 15 minutes of reading plus times table/number bond practice
- · Wednesday 15 minutes of reading plus spelling practice
- Thursday –15 minutes of reading, plus times table/number bond practice
- Friday 15 minutes of reading plus spelling practice

Children will be encouraged to use their Spelling Shed and Times Tables Rock Star accounts to support their personalised practice within these areas. (Class Teachers will send out reminders of log-in details).
