Each week one child's reading diary will be chosen at random and if that child has been heard read at home, by a parent or carer, five times that week, the whole class will receive a reward e.g., wearing slippers for the day or having no homework that week. Please discuss this fun challenge with your child and support them by listening to them read at home daily.
